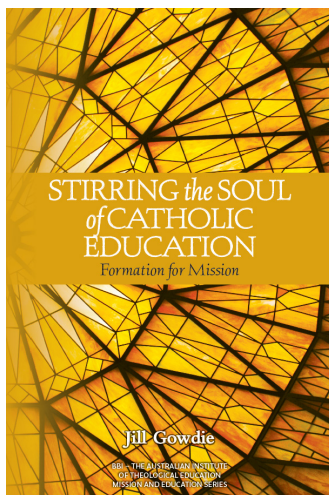
Stirring the Soul - Formation of Catholic Educators and Leaders

This exciting professional development seminar provides an opportunity for participants to explore the formational responsibilities of those who lead in Christian ministries. Facilitated by Dr Jill Gowdie, this seminar will allow participants to discuss and critique models of spiritual formation in the Catholic educational setting, and explore practical ideas and underpinning processes that participants can use and adopt into their own leadership contexts. For those wishing to extend their learning outcomes, this seminar may articulate into an academic unit which explores the notion of contemporary Christian mission and the implications of this for formation, outlining the contours of a new approach to formation.

DAY 1

Tuesday 9th July

SESSION 1

Setting the Scene

This session will introduce participants to the personal, professional, ecclesial, cultural and system contexts that influence a contemporary approach to formation for mission.

SESSION 2

Models of Spiritual Formation

This session will immerse participants in the range of approaches and models that have been developed by key thinkers and practitioners in the work of spiritual formation. It includes the distinctive Catholic model of religious life adapted from the monastic model.

SESSION 3

Current Models and Approaches in the Catholic Educational Setting

This session will focus on three current models and approaches being used in the Catholic educational setting. Each of these is quite distinct and together exemplify the range of stances about appropriate formation for Catholic educators and leaders.

DAY 2

Wednesday 10th July

SESSION 4

Mining the Learnings – Five Levers

In the previous session, we noted the strengths of current models and approaches in Catholic educational settings. In addition, we can identify five general 'levers' across the models that are instructional in further development, and which invite some further explication.

SESSION 5

Adult Spirituality

This session explores how adult spirituality is understood and what cultural factors are at play in the Australian context. The research in developmental theory and the process of spiritual formation and practice in Australia and internationally are critiqued. The historical development and understanding in Catholic faith formation and practice as it impacts on individual experience is analysed and, finally, the interface between Christian spirituality and contemporary theology is examined.

SESSION 6

Educational Culture

The educational environment has a particular culture and this is an essential lens in our understanding of appropriate formation.

The two-day professional learning seminar can articulate into an academic unit.

LEAD906 Unit - Stirring the Soul: Formation of Catholic Educators and Leaders

The LEAD906 unit, offered by BBI-TAITE continues from the seminar (or as an online unit) providing an in-depth study of the formational responsibilities of those who lead in Christian ministries. Focussing on the meaning, content and processes of formation, and also on the formational responsibilities of the leader, it examines insights drawn from the Christian faith tradition. Context, community and the needs of the leader, as well as issues concerning adult spirituality in Christian faith settings, are also addressed. In addition, the unit explores the notion of contemporary Christian mission and the implications of this for formation. It outlines the contours of a new approach to formation.
